Dear Families,

It has been another busy week in school with great learning taking place and new experiences enjoyed by our children. On Monday, Dahl Class had a visit from Jonathon Green of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park. We have been selected as one of 10 schools in the area to take part in this year's 'Birds on the Edge' programme. The children learnt about endangered birds in the area, constructed a bird feeder and placed it in the school car park. Children will now record birds that use the feeders in the month of May and report back their findings. A great local initiative that enables children to be active in their local environment and help support endangered species. Donaldson Class enjoyed their first dance session of the year with Miss Sarah from Sarah Louise Ashworth's dance school and the Maypole team were back in action this week practising for the upcoming Maypole dance in May. I have written to parents in Dahl and Year 1 this week with regards swimming lessons – more information is below.

Around the Classrooms:

Donaldson: This week, we have been exploring what an astronaut is, what they wear and the job they do before investigating Tim Peake further next week as part of our new project: 'Have you ever been to the moon?' In Maths, we have been investigating one more and one less within 50 in Year 1 and in Reception number bonds to 10. In English, we have been writing instructions on How to catch a star.

Dahl: This week, we had a great morning on Monday with Jonathon from North Yorkshire Moors 'Birds on the Edge' programme. In Maths, we have been exploring money and in English we have planned and drafted a set of instructions on mummification after our trip to the Oriental Museum in Durham. In History, we have investigated why, how and who built the pyramids in Ancient Egypt and in Science we completed our final session on the unit rocks and soils.

Rowling: This week, we have continued to draft, edit and then write up our recipe based on the 3 witches scene from MacBeth and in Maths Year 4 and 5 have been subtracting from mixed number fractions, whilst the Year 6 have been focusing on revision in preparation for their upcoming SATs. In Geography, we have investigated the climate of South America and in Science we have started our new unit on light, exploring the different types of light and creating shadows with puppets.



Pre-School:

This week, in Pre-school, we have enjoyed lots of outdoor play and also started our woodland adventures. We learnt and practiced the basic rules to help keep us all safe, such as stopping when we hear the first whistle and coming back to base camp when we hear the second whistle. The children did lots of exploring and all seemed to have a great time!



Swimming:

As per the letter sent out on Monday to families with children in Year 1 and Dahl class, swimming will finally take place for the next 4 Monday's that the children are in school. We have also asked for a parental contribution (£3 per session) to cover increasing costs.

For the last few years, we have managed to pay the full amount through school funds, however due to increased costs, the change of transport provider and more instructors required, we have had to ask parents for a small weekly contribution. As stated in the letter the vast majority of the costs will be met through existing school budgets. Thank you for your support.

Colour Run Date change:

Due to a clash of dates with the Year 6 transition programme the Colour Run hosted by Mr Jackson and FOSS will now take place on Wednesday 5th June. This is so that all children are able to participate. More details will follow in the coming weeks.
