This week children in Donaldson class welcomed 4 new additions to their classroom - temperate fish. ### Around the Classrooms:

**Donaldson:** This week, we have been investigating Neil Armstrong and the moon landing as part of our enquiry about astronauts and project, 'Have you ever been to the moon?' In Maths, we have been counting in 2s and 5s in Year 1 and building beyond 10 in Reception focusing on numbers 14 and 15. In English, we have been writing character descriptions using adjectives on Beegu from our new class book and in Science we have been exploring Spring and seasonal changes.



**Dahl:** This week, in English, we have completed our instructions on mummification and written a thank you letter to Durham University for our recent trip. In Maths, we have all continued to master time and in Science we have investigated the different layers of soil including topsoil and bedrock. In History, we have investigated the different Pharaohs who ruled Ancient Egypt and from the evidence given decided who was the most significant.

**Rowling:** This week, we have been rounding and comparing numbers in Maths in Years 4 and 5, with the Year 6s focusing on multi-step problems. In English, we have been completing our recipes based on the 3 witches' scene from MacBeth and in Science we have been exploring the eye and how it distinguishes between different types of light as part of our unit on light. In Geography, we have investigated the major mountain ranges of South America.



### Pre-School:

This week in Pre-school we have enjoyed our new super six book, 'How to Grow a Dinosaur' by Caryl Hart. This has inspired some great play in the dinosaur garden where the children have acted out the story using the different props and resources, along with lots of great discussions around the subject as we wondered if you could really grow dinosaurs! A life size T-rex footprint appeared in Pre-school which made us think lots about size, shape, and measure. The children needed to gather lots of objects to fill the footprint and used some great mathematical language in their play.



### Colour Run Date change:

Due to a clash of dates with the Year 6 transition programme the Colour Run hosted by Mr Jackson and FOSS will now take place on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June. This is so that all children can participate. More details will follow in the coming weeks.
